## **S.P.E.C.K.A Bible Reading Method**

**For this year's study, we will be examining the New Testament in nine months using the S.P.E.C.K.A method. Each Wednesday night, we will be coming together to discuss the chapters that we've read each week.**

**S: Is there any sin to avoid?**

**P: Is there any promise to claim?**

**E: Is there any good example to follow or bad example to avoid?**

**C: Is there any direct command to obey?**

**K: Is there any knowledge about who God is or how He works?**
